Some of my fondest memories of growing up were because of my heritage. I remember learning how to speak Portuguese with my Mom and Grandma. I was so fascinated every time I learned a new phrase and was eager to learn more. Every other Friday we would have traditionally made chorizo and linguica, my favorite meal. My mother would make a big boiled dinner and we would eat with great joy. On rare occasions, my mom would make bacalhau. Possibly my favorite part of my personal development from my heritage was going to my grandma's house. She grew up on the Açore islands of Pico and Terceira and would tell us of how beautiful Portugal was. She told us stories like how she would cook bread in the ground of the volcano on the island. My grandmother worked as a house cleaner her whole life and she gave whatever money she made to her children so that they could have a better life. This selflessness and dedication is something that my grandmother made sure to instill in me. This is possibly the greatest way my heritage has helped develop me into the person I am today. The Portuguese people are extremely hard workers and this exemplifies me.
